

FUNDRAISER INFORMATION

How to book fundraisers:

1. Your group must have or get a gaming license FOR ALL FUNDRAISERS – NO exception. go to: <http://www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/sports-culture/gambling-fundraising/gambling-licence-fundraising/class-d> (or search “Class D License”)
2. Fill out the booking form completely and pick an available date. Please note: we only have one fundraiser per day. When we receive the form completed, and a deposit is paid then a date will be confirmed and tickets will be printed.
3. We will print a minimum of 50 tickets and can print as many as you require.
4. We charge you \$10 dollars per ticket – what you make on top of that is up to you. We recommend charging \$15-20 a ticket MINIMUM. There is NO reserved seating! There is a \$500 non-refundable deposit for ALL fundraisers. This pays for the first 50 tickets (which is the minimum). If you need to change the date for any reason, you MUST give us 26 days notice, or you will lose your deposit.
5. Make sure you include the price you want to charge for the tickets on the booking form.
6. One week before the date of your fundraiser, please contact us to confirm expected numbers, so that our kitchen and floor staff are prepared for the numbers.
7. At the end of the night we will tally up the number of tickets redeemed. You will be required to pay \$10.00 for every ticket over 50. You have already paid for the first 50.
8. Each ticket holder is entitled to choose one dinner from our fundraiser menu and a sleeve of beer, highball, wine or pop. (Please see the fundraiser menu)
9. Tickets may be redeemed as long as the kitchen is open, only on the date of the fundraiser (printed on the ticket) and after the fundraisers official start time.
10. Absolutely NO Alcohol may be brought in/out of the pub. (Not in gift baskets, auction items, etc)
11. You are welcome to hold 50/50 draws, toonie tosses, etc. You must discuss this with the bar in advance. All draws, etc. must be held in the liquor-licensed area only. No minors are permitted to be involved, please keep all activity out of the restaurant. Must be of legal age (19) to participate in any draws/games.
12. RE: TOONIE Toss: We will loan you a bottle for the night for the purpose of your fundraiser if needed, as you are not allowed to bring alcohol onto the premises (It is recommended that you keep items in a car outside of the building).
13. Don't forget to bring your gaming license the night of your fundraiser, without it we will be not be able to hold fundraiser.
